Pathways Learning Contract

The Pathways Construction program is grant-funded, meaning there will be no cost to you for tuition, materials or books. This is a partnership between SCC, the Center for People in Need, various government and non-profit agencies and Lincoln area construction firms to quickly move people into the workplace and to increase their basic education level. This program is open to 400 students at a cost of \$5543 per student, and many people are making a commitment to you to help you get this training and then to help you find a job. Taking a class slot and not following through deprives someone else that also had the same needs.

What we ask from you is a commitment to attend class every day for 13 weeks, to be here on time, to give this your full attention, to be flexible and work with the instructors and staff, and to commit yourself fully to a new and intense training experience. Specifically can you commit to the following:

- The Pathways Construction class involves 150 hours (10 weeks, 5 days per week, 3 hours per day).
- The computer skills class involves one additional hour per day, 5 days per week (Mon/Tue/Wed/Thu/Fri)
- The career development and money management classes involves 2 hours per day, 2 days per week (Tue/Thu)
- One additional hour per week of individual instruction to be scheduled for you.
- On the job training and job shadowing as scheduled for you.
- Participate in interviews, focus groups and surveys aimed at constant program improvement.
- Minimum one hour meeting with case manager each week.
