## Ride For \$7.50 Bus Passes

**“RIDE FOR \$7.50”**  
**(FOR AN ENTIRE MONTH!)**

Buy 11 bus passes in a row and get the 12th for free at Star Tran only.

The ‘Ride for \$7.50’ Low Income Bus Pass Program is only for low income people.

**Documentation will no longer be required when a Pass purchase is made.**

However, the Customer will be asked to sign a statement that their income qualifies them for the pass. To qualify, income must be at or below 200% of the Federal HHS Poverty Guidelines. The chart below determines eligibility.

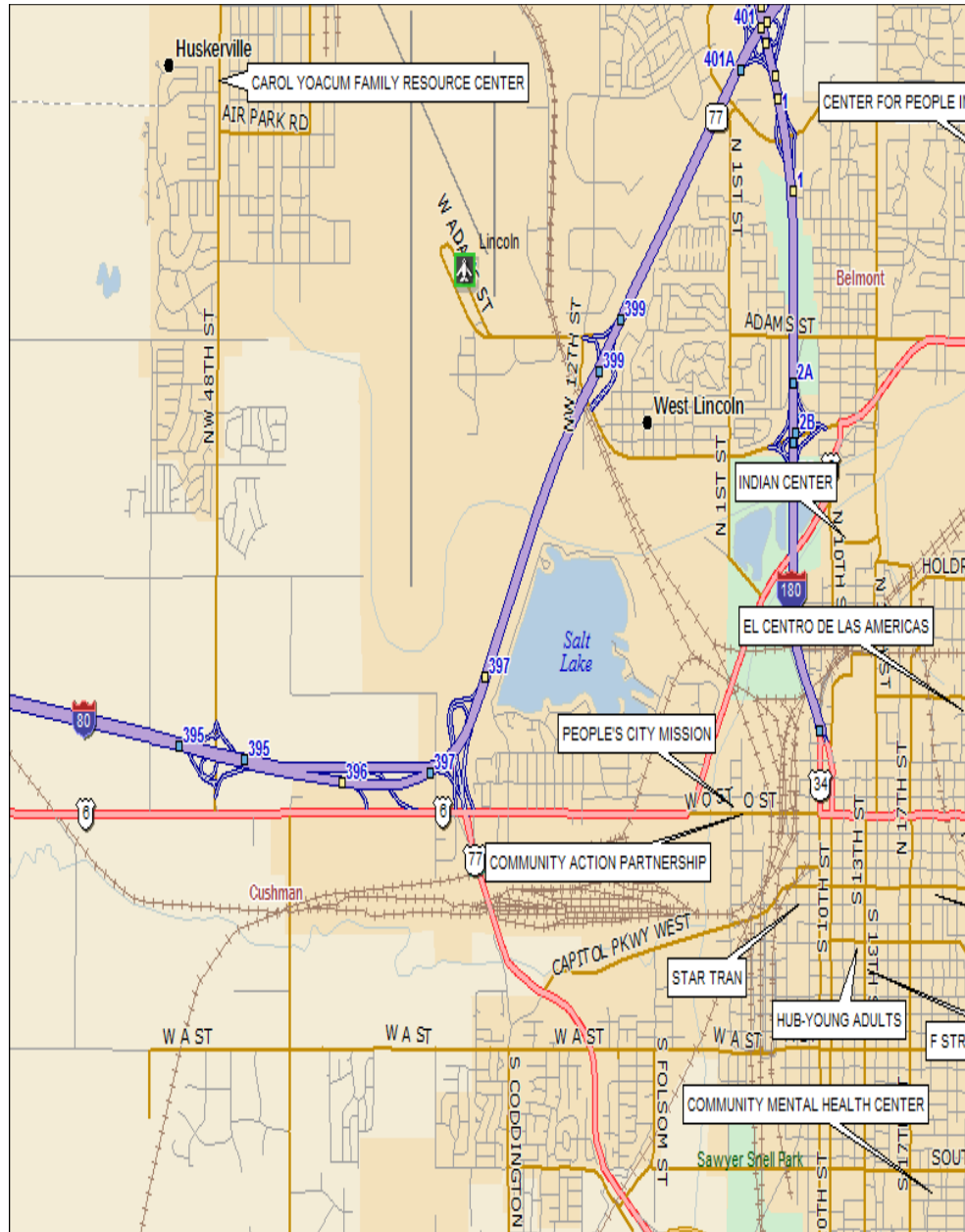

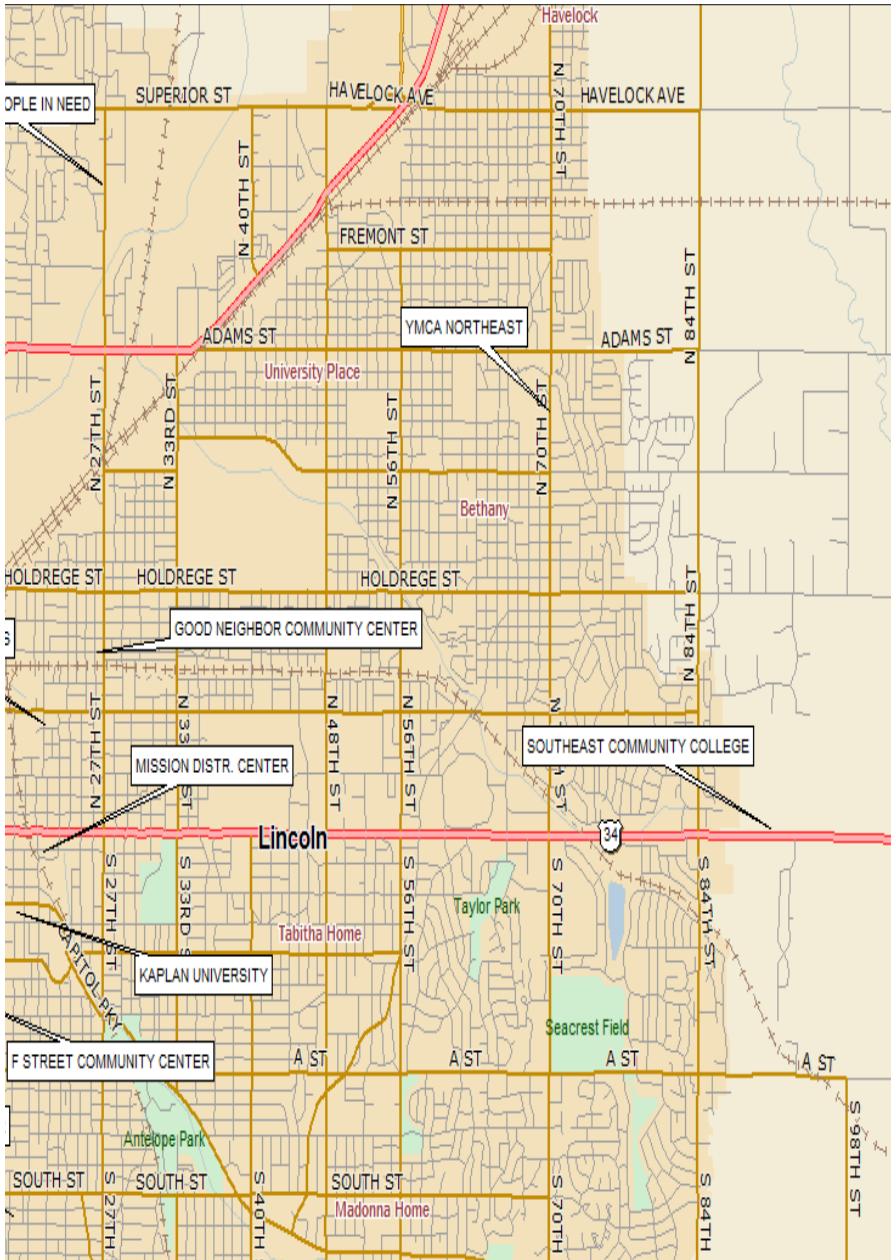
